Lin Xi is the prolific and award-winning lyricist behind the songs of many of Hong Kong's popular singers. He is noted for his songwriting partnership with composer Zhang Ya Dong for singer Faye Wong, as well as his compositions with and for Eason Chan, Miriam Yeung, Leslie Cheung, and Andy Lau, to name a few.

Lin Xi graduated in 1984 from the University of Hong Kong, School of Chinese, majoring in translation. His academic background and his deep engagement with words for his work has led to a unique literary grasp of the Chinese language, and its associated cultural meanings.

This talk will explore what it means to encounter and engage (whether actively or passively) with Chinese culture, and its influences and products that we see all around us, every day. From classical literature to the collecting of Chinese antiques, Lin Xi will discuss the insights and understanding—the secrets and treasures—he has gained about Chinese culture from various activities and pursuits.
